#### <u>Assessments</u>

Throughout the school year, the children will take part in a number of assessments, with the majority in the Summer Term – please see below for more details and dates:

## Year 1 KS1 Phonics Screening – week commencing 9<sup>th</sup> June 2025

Taken by all children in Year 1 in England and designed to give parents and teachers information on how well a child is progressing in Phonics. It helps to identify whether a child needs additional support so they do not fall behind in this vital early reading skill.

# Year 4 Multiplication Tables Check (MTC) – 2<sup>nd</sup> – 15<sup>th</sup> June 2025

To determine whether pupils can fluently recall their times tables up to 12, which is essential for future success in Mathematics. It also identifies children who may need more support.

## Year 6 Key Stage 2 Tests (SATS) – 12<sup>th</sup> – 15<sup>th</sup> May 2025

The KS2 tests will be taken on the dates set below:

Monday 12<sup>th</sup> May – English: Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling – 2 papers Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> May – English: Reading – 1 paper

Wednesday 14th May - Mathematics: Arithmetic and Reasoning - 2 papers

Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> May - Mathematics: Reasoning - 1 paper















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Children will be given standardised scores which will be communicated to parents. Please see the link below if you would like more information:
