Summer Term Assessments

During the Summer Term, summative assessments take place. Children are required to be in school for these assessments and holidays are strongly discouraged and will be unauthorised during a testing period.

Year 1 phonics test will take place week beginning 9th June.

Year 2 assessments in mathematics and reading will take place during the month of May before half-term (see below for more information)

Year 4 multiplication checks week commencing 2nd June.

Year 6 SATS commencing week beginning 12th May.

The results of the tests will be reported to parents along with their end of year report.

Year 2 assessments

In May, Year 2 children will be sitting non-statutory assessment tests as part of our end of term assessments. These assessments are in reading and maths. In the past, these tests (SATS) have been statutory and results of these tests have had to be reported to the government. This year it is no longer a statutory requirement but the assessments will be carried out to show a measure of progress within school as recommended by our Local Authority. This will inform teacher assessments to see if children are working towards the expected year 2 level, working at the expected year 2 level or working at greater depth.

These tests are referred to as "special year 2 jobs" and we try our upmost to avoid any pressure or stress on the children. Children will be familiar with the format through class work. Mrs Morris will begin sending assessment papers home so you can see the format and use them as homework. This will give the children additional practise as well as allowing you to see the types of questions the children will be asked. Please encourage your child to complete this homework. If you have any further queries regarding SATS, please see Mrs Morris.
