World Book Day

World Book Day is on Thursday 7^{th} March. Children will be receiving their £1 voucher during this week. Children may dress up as a book character on this day. Please remember to support the H.S.A with our sponsored read to help raise funds for new library books.

As part of our activities for World Book Day, we are offering the children a chance to take part in a book swap. If they have a book at home that they have read and no longer wish to keep, they may exchange their book for another brought in by a peer. Please note, books are permanently exchanged and cannot be returned to their original owner. This will take place on Wednesday 6th March.

Momo Challenge

You may be aware of a number of messages and warnings across the Internet describing an apparent phenomenon called the "Momo Challenge". Many such warnings claim it is a game where children are tricked into performing increasingly violent acts including self-harm, sometimes even culminating in suicide. Many such warnings claim the "game" is spreading on social media apps including Facebook and WhatsApp. Other warnings claim she is appearing on YouTube videos featuring Peppa Pig and Fortnite and games such as Roblox. Momo is usually illustrated by a wide eyed, dark haired woman with creepy facial features. The challenge is a prank. However,

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it has been brought to our attention that some of children have been exposed to this image through online access, social media and parents showing the child the image. Please may we ask parents to be vigilant and reinforce the message that this is not real as some children are beginning to discuss it in their friendship groups. We will not be mentioning this to children, as many remain unaware of the Momo Challenge. We will support children who mention it to us directly or disclose they have been made aware or are worried about it. We will be continuing with our e-safety curriculum to address safe internet use.
