Sharing Learning Session

Following the parentmail communication, we would like to remind you that you are invited you to a 'Sharing Learning' session on Monday 2nd December at 2:30pm. This will be an opportunity for you to share your child's learning in the classroom by going through their books with them and discussing what they have achieved over the year.

The class teacher will be in the classroom however it is not a parent consultation and therefore no private appointments will be available on this day. However, if you feel you would like to make an appointment to see your child's class teacher after viewing your child's books, please do so. Governors from the school will also be present to share the children's learning.

Christmas Performances

Please note the doors will not open on the Monday performance until 12:50pm to allow the school to clear the school lunch tables away. Due to the capacity in our school hall with increased pupil numbers, we are issuing tickets this year so that we do not exceed our fire regulation limit. Last year's afternoon performance was so well attended that some parents could not get into the hall and listened to the performance from the corridors. This year we want all parents to be able to watch their child's performance. Each family will be given two tickets. Each ticket admits one person to either the Monday or Tuesday performance. These tickets will be given to children to take home





and a Parentmail message issued to say when they have been distributed. Tickets must be presented at the door on the performance dates. Thank you for your co-operation.

Christmas Lunch for the children will take place on Tuesday 17th December. The cost will be £2.00 for any child in Y3/4/5/6 who wishes to join us. Children in Reception, Year 1 & 2 will receive the dinner free of charge, should you so wish, due to the Universal Free School Meals scheme.

We are hoping to have a special guest who will take time out of his busy schedule to come and visit us on this afternoon.

<u>Careers Week</u>

Recent research has shown that the large majority of children have decided upon a career path by the age of 7 and this changes very little after this age. As part of our school development priorities, we want to ensure our children are aspirational and have meaningful opportunities to encounter the world of work. We want to encourage our children to have a realistic view of possible career paths, broaden their horizons, increase their motivation to learn and challenge gender stereotypes. Therefore in the week beginning 20th January we will be running a careers week workshop for all children. Children will work with their teachers to explore employment options, learn about the importance and necessity of work to earn money and undertake reflection about their own strengths, skills and attributes that could be utilised in certain careers.

As part of this careers focus, we are asking if there any parents who would be willing to come into school week beginning 20th January to discuss their job with the children. We envisage a 5-10 minute presentation explaining their job title, job role, job skills needed, experiences and qualifications and route taken for that career.
