As Christmas is now fast approaching, I wanted to let you know about some of the festivities which will be taking place in school.

## <u>Christmas Lunch</u>

Children in Reception, Year 1 & 2 will receive the dinner free of charge, should they wish to join us, due to the Universal Free School Meals scheme.
