

Purple Day - Raising Awareness Of Epilepsy

As part of the Y5 & 6 citizenship curriculum, the older children have decided to take part in Purple Day. Celebrated annually on March 26, Epilepsy Awareness Day, or Purple Day, was created to increase the public's understanding of this brain disorder and to eliminate the fear and stigma surrounding it. Our school will be taking part on Friday 25th March. Children may come to school dressed in purple on this day in exchange for a small donation. The older children will be selling purple cakes at break time to the children (and if there are any cakes left, after school) to raise money for the charity. Year 5 & 6 will also be leading the assembly for children on this day to raise awareness of epilepsy. Please see the children's poster attached for further details.


