Please could we remind parents that school begins at 8:55am. We have some children who consistently receive a late mark due to starting school after 9am. Children begin their learning at 8:55am and it is essential children are in school and ready to learn by this time. Door opens at 8:45am.

Leave of absence during term time is only granted in exceptional circumstances. Family holidays are not considered exceptional circumstances. We would appreciate your support in this matter.

Head lice
