Christmas Performances

This year the children will be performing a production of 'Bethlehem Bake Off' for our Christmas play. We are delighted to invite families into school to watch the show however, we cannot accommodate everyone in the hall at once. Therefore, we have decided to put on two performances - one on Wednesday 13th December at 1:30pm for all families who have children in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2. The second will be on Thursday 14th December at 9:30am for our families who have children in Years 3 to Year 6.

Both performances will be identical with all age groups performing in both. If you have children in both key stage 1 and 2 please could you only attend one performance so that the hall does not get too overcrowded and everyone has the chance to see their child perform.

We must also ask that only two people attend the performance per family please. I hope you understand that we are simply trying to ensure that all families get a chance to attend working with the small space that we have. Thank you for your co-operation.

<u>Christmas Lunch</u>

Christmas Lunch for the children will take place on Thursday 14th December. The cost will be £2.20 for any child in Y3/4/5/6 who wishes to join us. Children in Reception, Year 1 & 2 will receive the dinner free of charge due to the Universal Free School Meals scheme. Children may still bring a packed lunch on this day if they wish to do so.
